

## Welsh Government has announced a national firebreak to help regain control of coronavirus

The national measures will apply to everyone in Wales and will last from 6pm on Friday, October 23 to Monday, November 9

### The five main rules:

1. People must stay at home, except for very limited purposes\*;
2. People must not visit other households or meet other people, indoors or outdoors, that they do not live with;
3. Certain businesses and venues, including bars, restaurants and most shops must close;
4. Primary schools (and secondary schools for Years 7 and 8) will remain open;
5. Face coverings continue to be mandatory in the indoor public spaces that remain open, including on public transport and in taxis.

#### \*Limited purposes include:

- Shopping for food medicines and household necessities – this should be done as infrequently as possible;
- Exercising locally, alone or with members of your household;
- To access childcare and education;
- To access medical services or other public services;
- To provide care for or to help a vulnerable person;
- To escape a risk of illness or injury, or to access services provided to victims of crime or domestic abuse;
- For work, voluntary or charitable purposes, where it is not reasonably practicable to do this from home;

**Please minimise the time spent away from home. When not at home, ensure you stay at least two metres away from anyone you don't live with.**
